## Project Description

WSSC Street Repairs IDIQ project provides paving and restoration services following a water or sewer main replacement or repair. Work includes restoring streets, concrete roadways, driveways, curbs, gutters and sidewalks.

Fort Myer is among 2 contractors responsible for street repair services including asphalt milling and paving roadways and driveways; removing and repairing curbs, gutters, shoulders, and sidewalks.

## Project Significance
