Project Description

Modification/rehabilitation of curbs and gutters, sidewalk and wheelchair/bicycle ramps, installation of a retaining wall at the corner of Reservoir Road NW and Foxhall Road NW, along with the upgrading of traffic signals, resurfacing the roadway and line striping from Reservoir Road NW to Nebraska Avenue NW (2 miles) to enhance all aspects of vehicular and pedestrian safety.

Project Significance

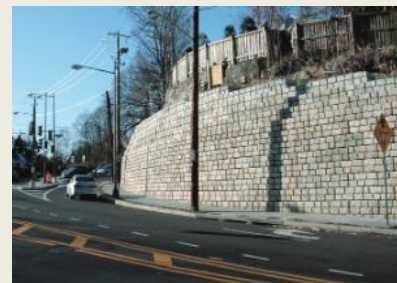
Highlights Fort Myer Construction's ability to complete important safety improvement projects in suburban areas of DC, with the goal of providing quality work and successfully completing the project expediently to minimize the inconvenience to residents.
