### Project Description

The Public Space Alley – Light System Relocation project was a time sensitive project subcontracted to Fort Myer Construction by McCullough Construction, LLC to replace the lighting system from the south side to the north side of the alley at this location in Northeast DC. The project was rushed due to the demolition of the Greenway Shopping Center at the intersection of Minnesota Avenue and East Capitol Street, NE.

Fort Myer's responsibilities included, the removal of 6 wood poles, overhead wiring, and removing of all existing lighting fixtures. Installation of new wood poles with 70W LED Cobra head fixtures and #6 Triplex for overhead ST LT power feed..
